### Who is it for?

Children who meet the eligibility criteria in Year 1 only.

### What will we do?

Explore singing, musical games, movement activities and musical instruments with friendly Royal College of Music Sparks Juniors teachers.

### Do we need experience?

No. Children can participate at their own pace in a safe, supportive and welcoming environment, so teachers can see each child's musical interests and potential.

### What happens at the end?

Based on musical potential shown during the course, some children may be offered a 5-year funded instrumental learning place with Sparks Juniors, or a 1-year funded choir membership at the local music hub.
