Our Learning

Maths

This week we were learning about the properties of 3D shapes. We also had fun building towers using 3d shapes, blocks, playing cards and lego.



English

We rewrote the story of the traditional tale 'The Firebird' in our own words.

Science

We discussed the positives and negatives between disposable and towelling nappies. Children overwhelmingly voted that disposable nappies were better than towelling nappies as they were more convenient, easy to carry on holiday, thrown away after use (no cleaning) and babies were more comfortable using them.

Geography


