



Geography

History

PE

Term 1
Gymnastics – Children will combine flexibility, balance and movement to create their own sequence over and under obstacles.

Term 2
Athletics – Children will develop their sprinting, running, throwing and jumping skills through athletic sports such as 100m sprint, long jump and javelin.



DT

Children will be able to:
Make – create a shell or a frame structure strengthening with diagonal struts.
Design – create a cross sectional drawing of their design.
Make – cut slots.
Make – create simple joins with wood.
Make – measure and make a square section and dowelling to the nearest cm,
Make – use a bradawl to make hole positions.
Make – use a hand drill to make tight holes and loose holes.



Art

Children will be able to:
Drawing – with a wax crayon, they can plan and use different pressure to produce a picture working from light to dark.
Independent Artist – choose suitable surfaces to work on.
