

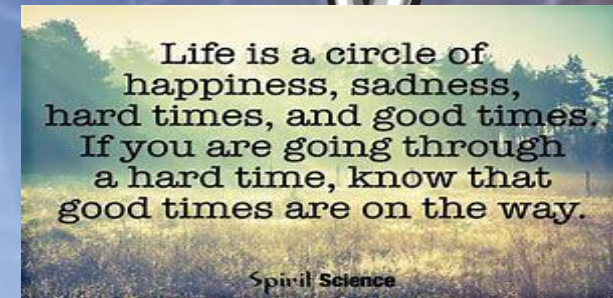
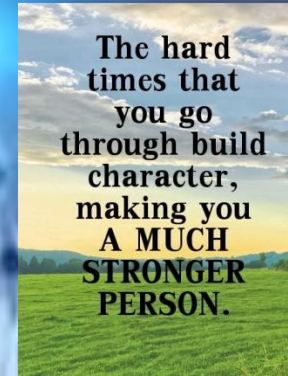
# The Knowledge of Kings



## Subject Specific Vocabulary

<b>Christian</b>	A person who follows the religion of Christianity.
<b>Hindu</b>	A person who follows the religion of Hinduism.
<b>Humanist</b>	People who follow non-religious beliefs.
<b>karma</b>	Hindu and Buddhism belief that the sum of a person's actions in this and previous states of existence
<b>salvation</b>	Being saved from danger, loss or harm.
<b>reincarnation</b>	A person or animal in whom a particular soul is believed to have been reborn.
<b>judgement</b>	The ability to make considered decisions or come to sensible conclusions
<b>bereavement</b>	A period of mourning after a loss, especially after the death of a loved one.
<b>ceremony</b>	A formal religious or public occasion.
<b>liturgies</b>	A form or formulary according to which public religious worship is conducted.
