
The next PTFA meeting will be on Wednesday 6th July 2022 in Foxes class. All are welcome.




The Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme, provides free physical activities as well as healthy, nutritional, hot meals, for four weeks over the summer break.



#### **School Attendance - Ongoing Reporting**

The information below shows that whole school attendance for the dates between 6th September 2021 and 30th June 2022 is currently **91.8%**, 0.1% up on when we reported 1 week ago.



This is still below the expected attendance rate of **96% or higher.** The national average for attendance in state funded primary schools was **92.3%** to April 2022, Wynstream Primary School is **0.5%** below this national average.



Current government guidance suggests that Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.

Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under who have a positive COVID 19 test the advice will be 3 days.


