



Levels of SEND

Level 1	<p><u>Cause for Concern</u></p> <p>School staff and parents can raise a concern about a child's learning, or needs. A child may be given support in school, for a short period of time, and then may come off of this, as they progress through the school.</p>
Level 2	<p><u>SEN Support</u></p> <p>Children will receive an Individual Education Plan when they need more support or when they have been on a Cause for Concern for a longer period of time.</p>
Level 3	<p><u>SEN Support</u></p> <p>When a child begins to receive support from outside agencies, such as the Educational Psychologist, they will move onto Level 3 support. This support will be detailed on their Individual Education Plan.</p>
Level 4	<p><u>SEN Support</u></p> <p>Level 4 support is given to children who require a greater level of support from different agencies. When a child is on Level 4, the school will be gathering evidence to support a request for EHCP assessment.</p>
Level 5	<p><u>EHCP</u></p> <p>When a child is provided with an Educational Health Care Plan, they receive additional support in school. They have support detailed within their EHCP and are supported by a range of adults.</p>
