Children talk to Bridford Parish Council

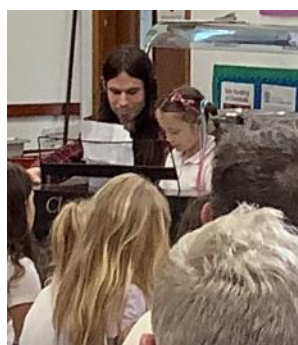
