


KIRFs

Key Instant Recall Facts



- ✓ KIRFs are number facts that children need to know securely.
- ✓ Children need to be able to recall them instantly to help them calculate in all areas of maths and move forward in their maths learning.
- ✓ Please help your child to understand and learn the key facts by playing games or asking them the questions for them to answer instantly (eg. White rose 1 minute maths).
- ✓ Children will be quizzed on these facts at the end of each half term.



How you can help your child with their Home Learning

- Create a <u>clear routine</u> for when you read with your child and record it in their diary.
- ✓ Ensure they have a calm and <u>quiet space</u>.
- ✓ Help them learn and <u>practise their reading list</u>, these activities can help make it fun....
- ✓ Maths homework → encourage your child to complete it and be available if your child needs help reading a question. Put a star by any questions they are struggling with.


