

# KIRF: I know the 3 times table (× and ÷)

A times table is a list of multiples of the given number. They are very important for many calculations. This half term, the children will be learning their 3 times tables including the division facts.

### Questions to ask at home

What is 3 multiplied by 8?

What is 8 times 3?

What is 24 divided by 3?

# Key vocabulary

3 multiplied by 6 is equal to 18

5 times 3 and 3 times 5 are equivalent

30 shared by 10 is equal to 3

27 divided by 9 equals 3


# What can this look like?

#### Concrete:



$$3 \times 2 = 6$$

#### Pictorial:



$$3 \times \boxed{7} = 21$$

## Things to challenge

If your child becomes confident with these multiplications try them with missing number questions e.g.

$$3 \times \bigcirc = 18$$
 or  $\bigcirc \div 3 = 1$ 

# Things to try

Chants- Practice chanting the times table.

Everyday Objects- Gather together objects and separate them into groups of 3.
