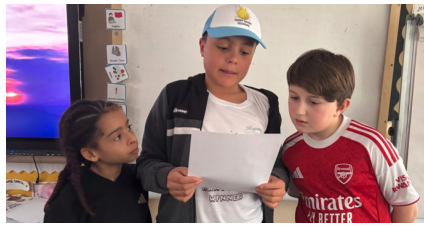

BREAKFAST CLUB
