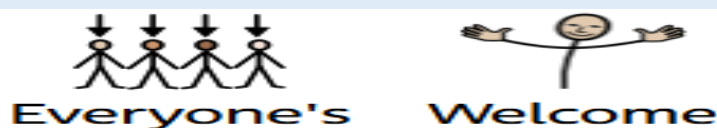

This term will see the launch of **Everyone's Welcome** at Belvoirdale. 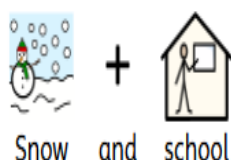

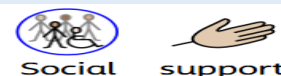

Anyone can access this brilliant, **FREE** and simple service. A **Social Prescriber** is a qualified help worker who is part of a bigger team who are based at every GP surgery and/or Family HUB Centre. They can offer advice and support to individuals and families about housing, behaviour, benefits, SEND, school places, health care, finance and *much more*. Belvoirdale has campaigned to get direct access to this NHS group and have met NHS England over recent months to secure more support for local schools. PLEASE ask in school for help and advice, or to be referred (name and address on a simple form) and this confidential and private service will help and support you in whatever you need. There will be meetings available in school in the coming months and it is hoped that Belvoirdale can help to expand the service as we have worked so hard to get more access and publicity for it.
