P.E – Attack Vs Defence focus

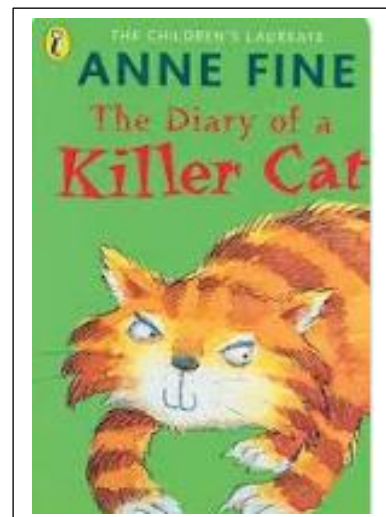
P.S.H.E – Changing Me – life cycle changes in nature
