## Key Stage 1 Performance of Lights, Camel Action

We look forward to welcoming family members of Key Stage 1 pupils to see Lights Camel Action this Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December.

The afternoon performance on Wednesday 7th will begin at 1.30pm and finish at approximately 2.45pm .

The morning performance on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> will begin at 9.30am and will finish at approximately 10.45am.

You may enter school via the main entrance from 1.15pm and 9.10am ready for the performances.

#### **Concert Recording**

I am pleased to inform you that we can now offer parents the chance to purchase a recording of the concert.

Please note that the recording will be done on a school IPAD, so will have no professional editing, but it will give parents access to the whole concert. A member of staff will record the performance and it will then be uploaded through a professional website, allowing parents to purchase a link if they so wish. The cost of this will be £4, which is considerably less than the company we usually use, and just covers the charge from the external company.

#### Carol Service - Friday 16th December, 2.00pm - St Alkmund's Church

We will be holding our annual Carol Service at St Alkmund's Church in Duffield on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December at 2.00pm. The service is particularly popular with Year 6 family members. Year 6 lead the service, however <u>all</u> parents, family and friends of the school are warmly invited to attend the service.

Parents new to the school, or with their first child in Reception will not have experienced the William Gilbert Carol Service before, so please read the details below carefully.

After lunch on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December, all the children walk with their peers, teachers and parent helpers. We arrive at Church in time for a toilet stop ahead of the service commencing at 2.00pm.

Children need to be dressed in their usual school uniform with tie and navy jumper - not a hoodie. Children should bring a waterproof coat in case the walk is in wet weather.

All children go home <u>directly from the Church at approximately 3.00pm</u>. Therefore, on the afternoon of Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December, all children need to be <u>picked up from Church</u>.

Unless I am informed in writing that your child is to return to school to be dismissed at 3.30pm, then it will be assumed that your child will go home from Church, and will be clear about their arrangements.

It is easier to bring as few bags as possible on the day of the Carol Service. Please place packed lunches in disposable packaging. **Infant children will not require their book bags on this day**.
