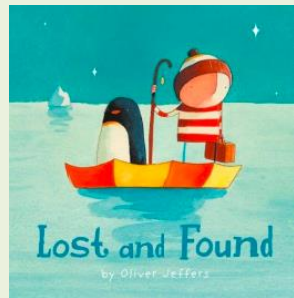

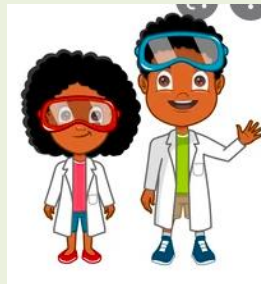

Health and Wellbeing

- Children can explain what can affect their health positively and negatively including dental health.
- They can share personal successes and describe how they achieved them.
- They can use vocabulary to describe the intensity of good and bad feelings and discuss ways to manage those feelings.
- They understand how and why they should keep themselves clean.
- They can describe a variety of ways to stay safe in different environments e.g. on the street, in school, on the internet.
- They understand when it is necessary to share secrets with others so they do not put themselves or others at risk.

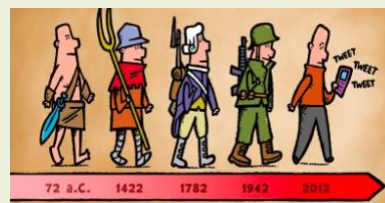


Geography

- Use the right points of a compass, four and six- figure grid references, symbols and key. Build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world.

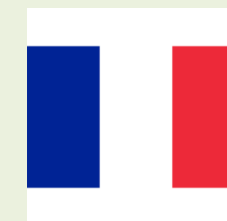
