Geography

At Kings Road, our Geography curriculum is designed to help children develop a deep understanding of the world around them. It is structured around substantive concepts (key facts about geography) and disciplinary concepts (how geographers study and interpret the world).









Through these concepts, children develop essential geographical skills, enabling them to explore how the world is organised, how it changes over time, and how different places are connected and unique. Each lesson builds on previous learning, and every topic strengthens their understanding of key ideas such as place, space, scale, environment, interconnections and cultural awareness.

Our aim is to spark children's curiosity about the world and encourage them to think like geographers. In the summer term, we will be taking part in Fieldwork Week, where the children will investigate our local area and apply their learning to answer real-world geographical questions.
