Key Vocabulary

<i>Islam</i>	<i>The word "Islam" means "submission to the will of the one God." It is the 2nd largest religion in the world after Christianity.</i>
<i>Muslim</i>	<i>Those who follow the Islamic faith are called Muslims, and there are around 1.9 billion Muslims in the world today.</i>
<i>Qur'an</i>	<i>The Koran (or Qur'an) is the holy book of Islam. According to Muslim tradition, God revealed the Koran to the prophet Muhammad in visions and messages over a period of 20 years.</i>
<i>Allah</i>	<i>The Arabic name that Muslims use for God.</i>
<i>Hadith</i>	<i>The Hadith is the collected traditions of the Prophet Muhammad, based on his sayings and actions.</i>
<i>Shahadah</i>	<i>This means to believe in Allah as the one true God and to believe that Muhammad is the last and final messenger.</i>
<i>Prophet</i>	<i>In religion, a prophet is one who speaks on behalf of a god or who is divinely inspired to reveal the will of a god.</i>
<i>Mohammed</i>	<i>The last prophet and the key prophet in Islam.</i>
<i>Prayer</i>	<i>Talking to God</i>
<i>The Five Pillars of Islam</i>	<i>The five things that Muslims are expected to do.</i>



Key Beliefs

Muslims believe that there is only one God called **Allah**. They believe **Allah** is the only ruler of the universe. The word '**Islam**' means submission and obedience to **Allah**.

Muhammad is so highly respected by **Muslims** that they will say "peace be upon him" after his name is spoken.
