Curriculum information



What are we focusing on?

We will be learning all about how plants grow. We will be making our own grass head and planting a bean so that we can watch it grow. We are hoping to send these home with the children so that you can continue to watch them grow during the half term.





In the Explorer's Class, our learning is firstly dictated by children's individual EHCP Outcomes. The children get a chance to play indoors and outdoors and this allows us to see what each child really likes and doesn't like. We will use these high interest ideas to help motivate the children.

Please let us know if they have new likes and dislikes as we know children often change their preferences and enjoy new things.



Chicks

This half term the school will be having some eggs delivered that will hatch into real life chicks. We will hopefully be able to visit them in very small groups to see what they look and sound like.

Maths



We will continue to look at numbers and will be focusing on the number 3. We will be counting up to 3 items and then seeing if your child can give us the correct amount when asked. We will also be counting up to 20 in order along with visuals and a song.



We will be watching short number blocks clips to help us with our understanding. You can help your child at home by counting out 3 items e.q. 3 cars, 3 trees.



Jumpers



As the weather is (hopefully) getting warmer, this is a gentle reminder to write your child's name in their jumpers and tops. The children also take their jumpers off during messy play and they all look very similar.

This half term, we will be experiencing Sensory Stories around growing and chicks. We will be trying to use all of our senses to get the children engaged and excited.
