Next Week, Eat with your family!

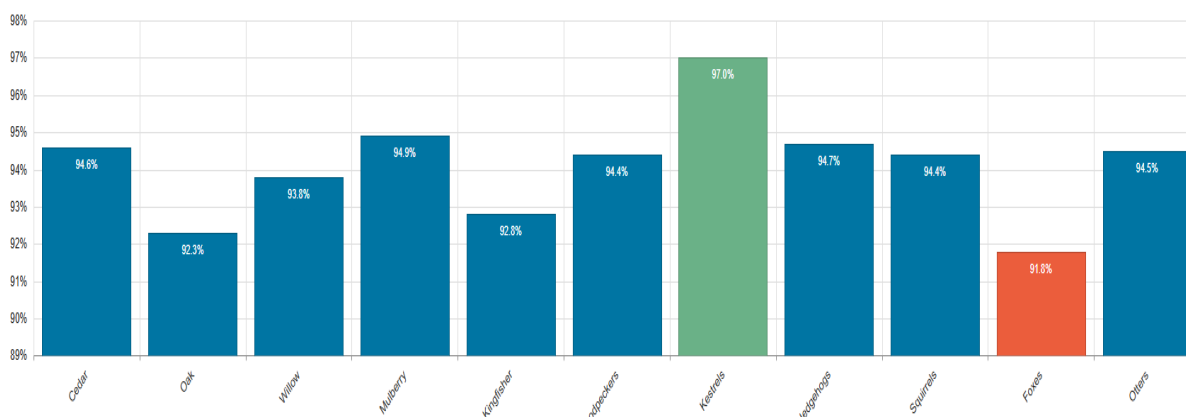
We're inviting Reception parents/carers to join us for lunch Week commencing 23rd January. Lunch will begin around 11:40 pm (some classes may be slightly later).
