To know decimal bonds to 1. To multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000

Key Facts		Key Vocabulary
0.1+0.9=1	7x10=70	What is 5 multiplied by 10?
0.2+0.8=1	10x7=70	What is 10 times 0.8?
0.3+0.7=1	70÷7=10	What is 700 divided by 70?
0.4+0.6=1	70÷10=7	What is the product of 30 and 10?
0.5+0.5=1	30x10=300	Thousands, hundreds, tens, ones, tenths, hundredths It might be tempting to tell your child to take off or add zeros when multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 or 1000. This does not work when calculating with decimals. Encourage your child to explain the effect of using place value and moving digits.
	10x30=300	
	300÷30=10	
	300÷10=30	
	0.8x10=8	
	10x0.8=8	
	8÷0.8=10	
	8÷10=0.8	
These are just examples of facts for this half term. Children should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions.
