The children spoke to experts about Winchester's history and the changing times of the cathedral during that time including its royal connections and revolts. They also learned about William Walker's achievements in saving the cathedral from collapse. Year 3 and 4 enjoyed a Roman Day workshop learning about why the Roman army were so powerful, Roman life and hierarchies. Children took part in lots of drama activities to support their learning.
