[Use parental controls on your child's iPhone, iPad and iPod touch](#)

Go to Settings and tap Screen Time. Tap Turn on Screen Time, then tap it again. Choose "This is My [Device]" or "This is My Child's [Device]". If you're the parent or guardian on your device and want to prevent another family member from changing your settings, tap Use Screen Time Passcode to create a passcode, then re-enter the passcode to confirm.
