As we begin the new school year, I would like to take a moment to thank the Friends of Kingsclere School (FKS) for all their incredible support over the years. Many of the original committee members, whose children have now moved on to secondary school, kindly stayed on last year to help organise events and fundraise for our school.



Understandably, after many years of dedication, many of the original committee members are now stepping down at the next Annual General Meeting (AGM). We now urgently need new parents and carers to take FKS forward and help run its events. Without additional support, these activities – and the funds they provide – cannot continue.

FKS raises around £12,000 each year, which helps fund vital resources and opportunities for our children. This support has kept the swimming pool running, funded our new library furniture, subsidised school trips, provided the Samba kit, funded learning apps, and much more. In addition, FKS organises key community events such as film nights, discos, Kingsfest, the fireworks display, and the Christmas Fayre.

Over the summer, Hampshire County Council Property Services, together with contractors Mountjoy, have been busy fitting a brand new roof for our school. This is an exciting improvement to our building that will benefit the school community for many years to come.

The scaffolding will remain in place for some time while the work is completed, and is likely to stay up until November. We would like to thank you for your patience and understanding while the scaffolding and building works are underway.

The good news is that much of the noisy work was carried out during the holidays, which means that disruption to the day-to-day running of the school will be kept to a minimum.

### School Lunch Menu – from September 2025

Children in Years R, 1 and 2 are entitled to a free hot meal each day, provided through the Government initiative. These are ordered in the classroom at registration, though children may also bring a packed lunch if you prefer.



Children in Years 3–6 can choose to bring a packed lunch or have a hot school meal at £3.00 per day, payable online via Reach More Parents and Parent Pay. Meals can be paid for daily, weekly, monthly, or termly.

We are a nut-free school, so please avoid nuts or nut-based products (including Nutella). Thank you for helping us to keep everyone safe.

To support healthy eating, we encourage balanced lunches and simple breaktime snacks of bread-based items, fruit, or vegetables. Some healthy packed lunch ideas include:

- Sandwiches, wraps or pittas with lean fillings, e.g., chicken, cheese, tuna
- Veg sticks with dip
- Fresh fruit or fruit salad
- Yogurt or cheese portions
- A small flapjack, muffin or rice cake
