I look forward to meeting parents who have booked to see me on the 30th March.


#### **Red Nose Day**




## **Fox Class activities**


#### **Maths**


We have now finished our **Length and Perimeter u**nit and have started learning about **Fractions**. We finished perimeter with an investigation. The children cut out five square tiles that each had a side of 5cm. They put the tiles together to make different shapes. Then they measured the perimeter. (See pictures below)



























## **English**

We have continued to write newspaper articles about the "Capture of the Iron Man". Children using their knowledge of the story to add direct quotes from an eyewitness using speech marks.

### **Science**

We made paper aeroplanes after learning about air resistance. We also went into the playground to test how far our paper aeroplanes flew before touching the ground.

In our topic Light and Shadows we were learning about which objects were opaque (blocks light) and which were transparent (lets through light). We also found out about how shadows are formed.
