Nursery Sessions

Morning Sessions starts at 8.45am—11.45am Afternoon Session starts at 12.15pm—3.15pm

The children will have access to a range of activities throughout the sessions.

These may include independent activities or group adult led activities.

These can take place inside or outside in our own courtyard.

Snack time is a set supervised time in both sessions.

The children select whether they would like a snack and help themselves. They sit at the table and have access to their water bottles or a cup of milk

Lunchtime session runs from 11.45am-12.15pm, charge is £5.

The children eat in the hall with the rest of the school. They are always supervised by a member of the nursery team and midday supervisors.

We have weekly opportunities to spend time in our woodland area. This is where we encourage the development of your child's emotional and physical development through outdoor play, activities and exploration in a natural environment.
