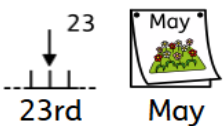
The 'Add Everyone' Explicit WhatsApp Group

Safeguarding Alert

In between supporting families and young people with a variety of social issues that affect us all, I spend a good majority of my headteacher time unpicking inappropriate online threats and abuse. The *Add Everyone* WhatsApp message that adds your entire phone book to a chat group, allowing complete strangers to talk to young people in an unfiltered way, as well as sending explicit images, is the latest addition to my daily concerns. I have discussed the following subjects with children and adults this week: Sexualised imagery and language, swearing, death threats, personal family insults and racial abuse. Please check your child's phone every day and please discuss the effects that online bullying and abuse has on young people. Please also take a moment to remind your children that being kind, being caring and saying something nice to someone (even your enemy), is still the coolest thing that anyone can ever do and is a sure-fire way to get you as many friends as you could ever want. *Mr. Dax*
