

# Careers with a Focus on PSHE

Careers with a focus on PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic education) primarily include specialised teaching roles (secondary, primary, and SEN), pastoral care leads, and roles in health, mentoring, or charity sectors focusing on student well-being. It also prepares individuals for roles in youth guidance, counselling, and social care.

## Key Careers with PSHE Specialism:

- [PSHE Teacher / Subject Lead](#): Teaching Relationships, Sex, and Health Education (RSHE) and living in the wider world.
- [SEN Teacher / SEND Teacher](#): Specialising in PSHE for pupils with special educational needs.
- [Pastoral Lead / Progress Lead](#): Overseeing student welfare and personal development.
- [SEMH Teacher](#): Supporting pupils with Social, Emotional, and Mental Health needs.
- [Nurture Teacher](#): Providing emotional support to students, often on a one-to-one or small-group basis.
- [Outreach Tutor](#): Helping students re-engage with education.
- [Preparation for Life Tutor](#): Delivering life skills curriculum.
- [Careers Adviser](#): Providing guidance on future work and life choices within a school setting.
