Leading up to the tree planting, children from our EYFS unit through to our Year Six classes sang songs, recited poems and performed stories for the visiting dignitaries. Some of the wonderful poems can be seen on pages 5,6 & 7 of this newsletter. The Queen's Green Canopy (QGC) invites organisations and communities across the United Kingdom to "Plant a Tree for the Jubilee" during the official planting season between October and March.

It is hoped as many people as possible will have the opportunity to plant a tree for the Queen's Jubilee celebrations. As well as inviting the planting of new trees, the project will dedicate a network of 70 Ancient Woodlands across the United Kingdom and identify 70 Ancient Trees to celebrate Her Majesty's 70 years of service. Mr Fursdon said: "I am honoured to have been invited to Wynstream Primary School to present this sapling. "When this tree matures in 20 years' time it will be the children of the pupils here today who will be playing underneath it. "Trees are a symbol of hope for the future and trees like this will benefit many generations to come." Mrs Gill Brown, Headteacher said: "I want to thank the Lord Lieutenant for presenting this tree. "I hope that trees like this will inspire the children and help them understand the importance of the natural environment as they will be the future custodians of our green spaces, forests and woodlands." 


Classes start at 8:40am and end at 3:10pm, children must be in class at 8:40am. Late arrivals should be through the school reception so that arrival can registered.


