This week in Reception

Phonics:

In Phonics this week, we will be saying the phonemes 'v, w, x, y' and recognising the graphemes 'v, w, x y.' We will be reading on sight: put, pull, full. We will be learning the 'tricky' words: has, her and his. We will be spelling: fat, sock, sad, hug and rock.

Things to note:

Both Reception classes participate in a forest school lesson on Monday. Please ensure your child has a pair of wellies in school (if they don't have already) and a waterproof coat. They may come into school in black or navy jogging bottoms on that day with their usual school t-shirt and jumper.

What we are learning:

We will be continuing to explore our topic of Light and Dark. We will share a non-fiction book about Fireworks and learn about Guy Fawkes and why we have fireworks. We will share our recent experiences of seeing and hearing fireworks using describing words. In maths, we will work on describing 2D shapes and using positional language. In mastering number we will be looking at the parts which make up a whole number eg 4 is 3 and 1.

At Home:

Please practise forming the letters in your child's name using cursive letters.

The correct cursive formation of letters can also be practised using the Letterjoin App or paintbrushes or in the sand etc



And finally: We will be visiting the Windy Arbour post office later this month to buy a stamp to post our letters to Father Christmas.
