"PSHCE education is a planned programme of learning through which children and young people acquire the knowledge, understanding and skills they need to manage their lives. As part of a whole school approach, PSHE develops the qualities and attributes pupils need to thrive as individuals, family members and members of society." The PSHE Association

At Newbold Church of England Primary School, we teach the key skills through the following eight areas:

- Health
- RSE
- Financial Capability
- Citizenship
- Votes for Children
- Enrichment Activities
- ELSA

PSHCE (like SMSC) is embedded throughout daily life at Newbold. We model positive relationships, self-image and communication skills with others in all our day-to-day interactions, as well as teaching skills explicitly in discrete subjects such as Circle Time, Votes for Children, P.S.H.E. lessons and collective worship. Children at Newbold also experience these key skills through RE, history, geography, literacy, maths, art, music and science, as well as outdoor learning, educational visits and links with the wider community.

Coverage of these areas, and our supportive Christian Vision, are already embedded here at Newbold, we aim to ensure that we produce well-rounded, happy and healthy children - ready for the wider world.

Relationship and Sex Education

We follow our relationship and sex education policy which has been written after consultation with parents. We use Cambridgeshire resources, also linked to science, which provides focused learning for all year groups covering all areas of relationship and sex education.
