WHY?

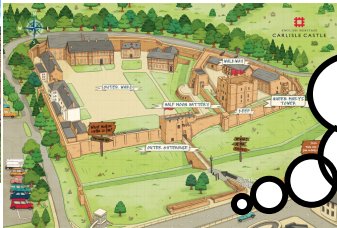
Why was Carlisle Castle built?

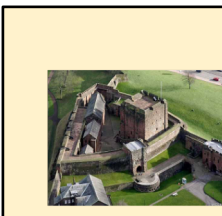
TIMELINE OF THE USES OF CARLSILE CASTLE
