

Each pathway will dictate their own professional dress code

Year 10 – (Key Stage 4) Engineering and Digital Pathways

- Navy polo shirt with UTC log
- Black cargo trousers
- Navy sweatshirt with UTC logo
- Plain black shoes (black trainers may be worn as long as plain black – no logos)
- Navy Blue zipped hoodie with UTC logo
- Large bag, large enough for carrying all equipment and books

Year 10 – (Key Stage 4) Health Care Pathway

- Navy Blue scrubs (top and trousers) with UTC logo
- Plain black shoes or plain black crocs (black trainers may be worn as long as plain black – no logos)
- Navy Blue zipped hoodie with UTC logo
- Large bag, large enough for carrying all equipment and book

Year 12 (Key Stage 5)

Students may wear casual clothing so long as it does not contain any offensive imagery or text, any imagery or text that promotes a life style or acts associated with illegal activity or does not sufficiently cover their body.

PE, Sports Wear and Exercise

Students may wear any appropriate attire for these activities provided it is not their everyday wear or their PPE clothing. Sport kit should be comfortable and suitable for exercise.

Students will need trainers, shorts, SDUTC sports polo shirt and socks. They will change into their sports wear at the start of their lesson and out of it at the end, and therefore should be in the expected dress code as stated above.
