



Winter	The season after Autumn and before Spring.	<p>Questions to ask your child</p> <p>What do you know about winter? What is ice made from? What happens to ice when it gets warm? What is the Arctic/Antarctic like? How can we keep warm in winter? Where do penguins live?</p> <p>What adaptations do penguins have to live in cold places?</p> <p>Activities to do together at home across this half term:</p> <p>Draw a picture of someone dressed for a cold winter day and then label the clothes they are wearing to keep them warm and dry.</p> <p>Go on a winter walk with a grown-up and look around to see the things that have changed since the autumn.</p> <p>Some animals live in cold places around the world. Draw a picture of an animal that lives in a cold place and find out a fact to share with the class about your animal.</p> <p>A squirrel hid 8 nuts for the winter. He has already eaten 5 of them. How many nuts has he got left? You could draw a picture or use your fingers to help you work out the answer.</p> <p>Design a scarf. You could draw it, paint it or even use other materials to make a collage.</p>	
Ice	When water cools to 0 degrees Celsius it changes to a solid which is ice.		
Predator	An animal that hunts others for food.		
Prey	An animal hunted or killed by another animal for food.		
Camouflage	The disguising of an animal to hide from predators or prey.		
Environment	Everything around us including air, soil, water, land, plants and animals.		
Adaption	Something a living thing has to help it to survive.
