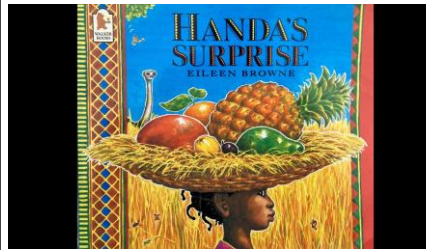


This week in Reception

Phonics:

We will revisit all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs - ai, oa ee, igh, ur, or, er, ar, ow, oi, ear, air. We will be reading and writing CVCC words including champ, chimp, chest, punch, bench, munch, shift, shelf, hunt, cost, melt, milk, shrink, crack, smash, frog, smell, swim, drink, dress, plug, bring and truck. We will be writing sentences and focusing in clear spaces between words. We will be reading and writing the 'tricky' words: **some, come, love, do.**

What we are learning:

We will be starting a new topic about food and we are very excited to be exploring where our food comes from on our visit to the farm on Friday 17th April. In our Literacy this week, we will be sharing Handa's Surprise and exploring the story setting. We will be comparing the setting of Kenya to where we live, Kenilworth.

In maths, we will be focusing on the composition of numbers revisiting the pairs of numbers which make 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.
