1. **Newsfeed** – This will now be used only for class stories and photos. It's the place to go if you want to see what's been happening in your child's class or view pictures from enrichment activities across the school.
2. **Notices** – This is where you'll find whole-school information, including letters, key dates, reminders, and updates. If you're looking for something important, this is the section to check first.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Our attendance target this year is 95%, and we need your support to reach it! When children attend school regularly, they build strong friendships, develop good learning habits, and make steady progress in their education. Together, we can make every day count!

SUPPORTING LEARNING AT HOME

We are proud of the strong home-school partnership we've built to support pupils in becoming confident, independent learners. Here are some of the ways we promote learning at home:

- **Daily Reading Books:** Pupils take home reading books every day (along with sight words in younger classes), to encourage regular reading practice and build fluency. This daily habit helps foster a love of reading and strengthens key literacy skills.
- **Talk Tasks:** Every Friday, pupils receive a Talk Task to complete over the weekend. These tasks are designed to spark meaningful conversations at home and develop speaking and listening skills, ahead of a new learning week.
- **Online Learning Platforms:** During a number of our Learn with Me sessions, families were introduced to the online platforms we use to support learning at home. These include:
 - SumDog - our numeracy platform, which pupils access Monday to Friday for home learning tasks
 - Oxford Reading Buddy - to support reading fluency and understanding of text.

We are committed to making learning accessible across school and home. Thank you to all our families for your continued support in helping our pupils thrive! Please do get in touch for any questions you may have about supporting your child.
