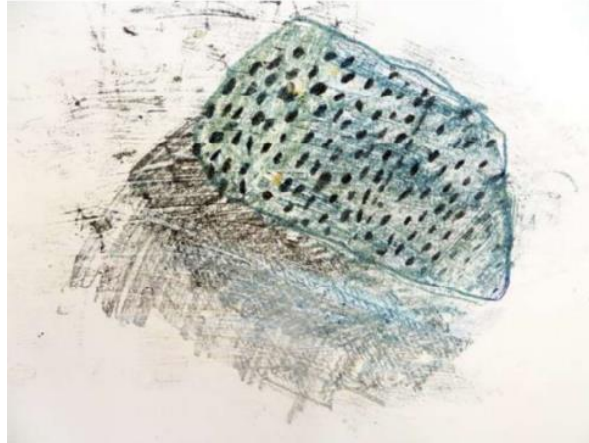


Key Vocabulary

Key Word	Definition
close looking	Looking carefully at detail.
mark making	To create patterns, lines and shapes.
experiment	To test something out.
represent	To show the likeness of something.
life size	The same size as the object.
scale	The physical size of objects.
form	3D objects.
shadow	The dark side of an object not facing the light.
feedback	What someone has done well and could improve.
respond	Describing what we see.
monoprint	A print which can only be made once.
monotype	A single print taken from a painting.
carbon paper	A thin paper coated in ink.
image	A picture of something.
