As part of this ongoing process, the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) and the Safeguarding team have recently reviewed our morning routines.

While there are only limited changes, we kindly ask that you familiarise yourselves with the following reminders:

- Parents should not enter classrooms or other indoor areas of the school without prior consent or invitation.
- To ensure a smooth and safe start to the school day, we ask that messages to staff during the morning handover are kept to a minimum. If you have important information to share, please use the school app, and it will be passed on to the relevant staff members.
- From Monday, you will notice teachers standing further back towards the classroom doors. This adjustment further strengthens our morning routines.
- Please avoid approaching teachers with messages until all children are safely inside the building.

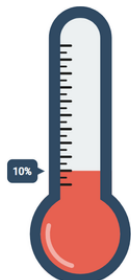
