 villages	A settlement that has a few houses and sometimes a shop, a school and a village hall.
 towns	A bigger settlement, usually with shops, schools, restaurants and other businesses.
 city	A very large settlement where thousands of people live and work with all sorts of businesses.
 government	A group of people in charge of a country who make the rules.
 country	An area of land with its own government, rules and borders.
 United Kingdom	A place that is made of four countries: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
 Island	An area of land surrounded by water.
