##### Reading volunteers

We are incredibly fortunate to have reading volunteers who give up their time to come into Kings Road to support our children.

In Year 1 and Year 2, Nimi, Ishbel and Noel come in for one or two sessions per week. They work with individual children, playing word games, solving word puzzles and reading together. These individual sessions are up to 30 minutes each, which means these children get up to one hour's extra reading support every week!

Gillian works with Year 2 and Year 4 children. She comes in to school twice a week and supports several children in each class, hearing them read and chatting about the texts.
