Earrings

A further point regarding uniform is that of earrings. After much conversation and deliberation, we have reviewed this policy and children can now have **one** plain small (gold or silver) ball stud earring in each ear. No jewels in it and it should be no more than 3mm in diameter. Parents who send their children in wearing these, do so at their own risk but it is ultimately their choice. We will review this at the end of the year and if there are no issues make it a permanent change. Please be clear though that the best thing, purely relating to safety, is for children not to wear earrings but we respect the decision of parents as long as it is within the parameters listed above.

Please refrain from putting tape on earrings now as this actually is more dangerous, looks appalling and is incredibly uncomfortable for the children.

I am incredibly excited about the year that we have planned for the children and also for you as families as we look at how we can work best together as a team to enable each and every child to surpass all their expectations of what they can achieve.

Coffee and chat morning followed by Makaton Parents Workshop – Wednesday 18th September from 8.30am.


Prayer and Reflection
