Year Five

We have been learning how to code micro:bits. We have programmed them to produce an output dependent on the input. We created code, using *makecode*, to show a smiley or sad face dependent on the input. We also made code that programmed the micro:bits to display rock, paper or scissors when it was shaken. This allowed the children to understand how selection variables can be used within coding.
