Where can I find lesson materials?

You will find the powerpoints for each lesson, and the notes booklet that accompanies each section of the specification, in **Teams** and **Sharepoint**

You have the booklets printed out, and there are spare copies in the drawers in Room E, if you need them.

The **full specification** is in our Teams area, and sharepoint (and in a printed booklet!), so you can check your notes to ensure that they are complete.

For each area of the specification, you should have your own notes (from class), as well as a booklet.

What does homework look like?

Homework this year is in the form of **exam-style questions**. You will revise an area of the **specification**, through **Guided Learning tasks** (which will require you to transform information from your classnotes and booklets, into revision material) and you will **apply this knowledge** to an exam question. Homework is set on a Thursday and handed in the following Wednesday. Homework is set on **Classcharts**.

When you receive **feedback** in class, you will have the **opportunity to add detail**, and look at **example answers**, to help you to improve your **exam technique**.

What does Guided Learning look like?

You have **Guided Learning booklets** that focus on specific areas of the specification. The tasks in the booklets guide you through techniques for **transforming the information** that is in your booklets and classnotes, into revision materials. This is to help you to start the process of **revision** from the beginning of the year, and to help you to find **revision methods** and **recall techniques** that work for you.

What you have revised in Guided Learning will then be applied in your exam questions for homework.
