Dear Families,

In English, this week we have been learning about and writing recipes. Children used their own ideas to write a recipe for making a sandwich, bagel, salad or a favourite dish. They included a list of ingredients, equipment, method and pictures and diagrams.

In maths, we were learning how to add and subtract 100s. Children used place value charts and the bar model methods to support their learning.

In RE, we focused on Mark 4:37-41, 'Jesus Calms the Storm'. Children discussed the question why Jesus calming the storm was important.

In History, we were learning how early people lived at Skara Brae in Scotland during the Neolithic period.

In Science, we discussed how our muscles work in our topic 'Food and our Bodies' and labelled different muscles on a diagram of a body. The children also drew pictures of the movement of the arms and found

out that the biceps and triceps muscles get shorter or longer when they are moving.
