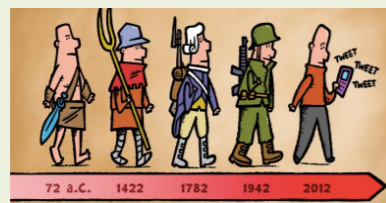
## Geography
