New Waste Regulations Packed Lunches

You will remember from our previous communication that children who bring packed lunches to school will need to take any leftover food, packaging, and other waste items home with them at the end of the school day. We are starting this from Monday 31st March 2025.

We understand that this may require some adjustments, but we believe it is an important step toward reducing our environmental impact.

To help with this transition, we kindly ask that you:

- Pack items in reusable containers where possible to minimize single-use packaging
- Ensure your child has a way to bring home any waste or leftovers, such as a small reusable bag or a container for disposal
