In Phonics, we will be applying long vowel phonemes to the reading and spelling of words such as sleep, slight, croak, crown, screech, sprain, strain, stair, three, spoil, sploit. We will be exploring the meaning of the words. We will say the following sentence 3 times, and count the words. We will segment the sounds in the words and write the sentence using cursive letter formation: 'The star lights up the dark.'

Our sports morning will be taking place on Friday 19th June and children will wear their PE kits on that day. Parents are welcome to join us.

What we are learning:

In Literacy, we will be anticipating key events in the story of My Granny went to market. 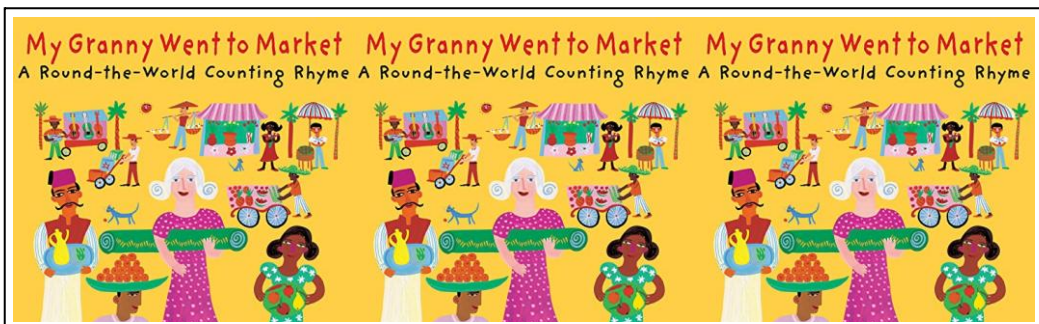
In maths, we will be focusing on sharing a number into groups of equal size, and exploring which numbers we cannot share fairly.
