English is one of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.



  Helps children to make even more progress.
















#### What can I do?


- 1. Watch the sound production videos for parents so that you are using 'soft sounds'.
- 2. Practise the sounds and phrases.
- 3. Practise reading sounds speedily.
- 4. Help your child use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk' to read words.
- 5. Watch the Virtual Classroom films together.



# Phonics Screening Check

- This takes place in the Summer term of Year 1 and it set externally.
- All children who are eligible, complete this phonics check with an adult in school.
- The children's score are reported to the government.
- Retake in Year 2 if they do not pass.
