



Early Years Foundation Stage...


Reception will be your child's first year of school.

All 4-5 year olds follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum.


At SJV we believe that children who feel happy and safe in an environment where they can explore and investigate will be successful learners.

Learning in Reception is achieved through a variety of play based activities, some that are led by the children and some that are enhanced by adult intervention.

Alongside independent learning we deliver short focused teaching sessions where the children are taught Phonics, Maths and early writing and where we encourage a love of story telling, singing and learning!

Phonics is taught through a systematic synthetic phonics program called Read Write Inc. All reading books are matched to ability through Read Write Inc.



English is taught through a quality text approach, utilising RWI approaches.




Religious Education is taught using the To Know You More Clearly programme of study.





Maths is taught using the White Rose Maths Mastery approach and Mastering Number.




Parent Workshops...

Maybe today was the very first time


That my scissors followed a very straight line,














Drinks...

Please send your child to school with a water bottle. Children can drink water throughout the day, helping to keep them hydrated and ready to learn.


No juice please.

Snack...

Your child will be provided with a snack each day in Reception.


Children can access 'rolling snack' between 10am-11:30am daily. They will be able to help themselves and prepare their own food.

Snack money costs £2.50 per week and can be paid weekly, half termly or for the entire year.









School Lunch...

All infant aged children are currently entitled to free school meals.


There is a choice each day between a hot meal and a vegetarian option. There is also salad available everyday from the salad cart. Parents and carers are responsible to choose children's school meals through School Grid which you can access through the Reach More Parent App this allows parents to know exactly what the children are eating at school.

Class Dojo...

It is important that you are fully connected and active prior to your child starting school. Please download the app onto your phone and you will be able to contact Miss Lowdon directly.

It may be a short message to say that a Grandparent is picking up your child that day or perhaps that your child is feeling a little under the weather that day. The message will reach me straight away.

Within the Class Dojo app, you will also see the things that your child is being rewarded for in class too.



Absence and Illness...

Please make sure your child is in school at 8:45am. We aim to have a prompt start to the school day.

If your child is ill, please either contact the school office on the first day of absence to let them know or you can notify us using the Reach More Parents app.



If your child is persistently late or absent, you will be contacted by school and invited to attend a meeting to discuss ways that we can support you.

Regular lateness and absences have a negative effect on children's learning and their social and emotional well-being.



Breakfast Club...

Breakfast Club starts at 07:45am at a cost of only £5 per session if you book on an 'as and when' basis. However, if you enter a contract and book in advance, the cost per session is reduced to £4 per session.


Breakfast is included for those children who arrive before 08:30.

You can book sessions on the teachers 2 parents app.











After School Club...

3.15pm-5.30pm at a cost of £9 per child, per day if on contracted days or £10 for bookings as and when needed.










We always need new members to help with our PTFA events!






In September, your child will need...

Please ensure that everything is labelled with their name.





Taster Sessions...






