### Key content/other useful information

The AQA Art and Design assessment objectives are designed to evaluate students' abilities across various components of their coursework. These objectives are equally weighted and are as follows:

**AO1:** Develop ideas through investigations

- Students are expected to demonstrate critical understanding of sources and develop their ideas through thorough investigations. This includes exploring various themes and concepts relevant to their work.

**AO2:** Refine work by exploring ideas

- This objective emphasizes the importance of experimentation with appropriate media, materials, techniques, and processes. Students should show their ability to refine their ideas and work through various iterations.

**AO3:** Record ideas, observations, and insights

- Students must document their creative process, including observations and insights that are relevant to their intentions. This can involve sketching, writing annotations, and other forms of documentation that support their artistic development.

**AO4:** Present a personal and meaningful response

- The final objective requires students to present a coherent and personal response that realizes their intentions. This includes demonstrating an understanding of visual language and effectively communicating their ideas through their artwork.
