Children will learn to:

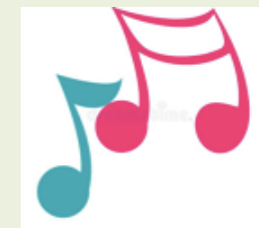
