

Daily Organisation

- Lunches should be ordered using the schools online system Orian before each school day.
- Any queries/problems, staff are available before or after school outside their classrooms. Class doors will close at 8:50
- Children may cry initially but it soon stops.
- They enter the classroom, put their personal things away and then registration takes place.
- There is a "Golden Book" assembly on Friday mornings at 9:00am.
- We do a phonics and maths session daily.



In the Class

- Sometimes children will work in small groups, independently or as a whole class.
- We plan for opportunities throughout the day for teacher and child led activities. We follow your children's interests. If you notice your child has a new interest please write this on Tapestry.
- We ensure indoor and outdoor activities every day so please make sure they have appropriate clothing for the weather.

Every child needs a labelled water bottle that they bring with them daily.




What you can do to help!

- Ensure children read their book every night.
- Ask your children about the sounds and rhymes they have been learning in school.
- Read bedtime stories.
- Sing nursery rhymes
- Show children your writing, shopping lists, things to do, birthday cards.
- Develop fine motor skills by cutting, playing with toy tweezers, dot-to-dots etc.
- Point out numbers around you, on houses, cars, television channels, cookers and microwaves.
- Compare quantities, who has the most sweets, which shopping bag is heavier?




Reading at home

- Children bring home reading books each day, from quite an early point in the 1st term.
- Please share these with your child, reading to them and encouraging them to read to you as they gain confidence.
- Repetition is the key.



Practical Details

- Please ensure all uniform is labelled with child's name.
- Uniform includes, grey or black trousers/skirt, summer dress, grey pinafore, white or royal blue polo top, blue jumper. School shoes/trainers must be black without any other colours on them. You can also purchase school book bags at the school office.
- Packed lunches in named lunch box
 - No chocolate, sweets, fizzy drinks.
- We provide fruit for break time.







Practical Details

- Children have "accidents". Please can you provide a set of spare clothes that can be kept on their peg just in case.
- The day starts at 8:45am and we finish at 3.10pm. Children will be collected from the classroom.
- If, for some reason, someone different is picking your child up, please let us know.
 They must be on your contact form and have the password you have chosen.
- Children will be very tired initially, school is hard work when you are 4!



Medical Matters

- Any sickness, diarrhoea, must be followed by 48 hrs absence.
- Head lice; Please check regularly and treat as recommended.
- Any absence requires a note or telephone call explaining why.
- Any medicines can only be administered by prior arrangement with the office staff. A form must be completed.
- Please make sure that your contact forms are kept up to date with yours and your emergency contacts information.
- Please remember we are a NUT FREE school.




